Look 2

The gorgeous star, who was a presenter at the awards, appeared on the carpet with an eye-popping, ginger hued, chin-length wavy 'do that looked spectacular. Sharing inside hair scoops, Ken confided "Jess has always wanted to be a red head" and the "sizzling 100% all human hair" offered Jessica a "hot new hair look without commitment."

Anyone can easily duplicate Jessica's instant switch from light butter blonde to ginger by selecting the 15-inch HairDo Clip-in Wavy Hair Extension in either R130 Dark Copper or R29S Glazed Strawberry.

Step 1 Create horizontal part from temple to temple along the back crown of the head.

Step 2 Clip the top section of hair up.

Step 5 Remove the clip holding the top hair in place.

High ponytails offer many advantages from providing a sleek finish, a lot of swish (if desired) and it helps to focus attention on the cheekbones. Hollywood hairdressers have always used high ponytails to create an "instant" face lift. Not that the lovely songbird needs any help in that department.

Step 1 Using a brush, comb or your fingers, smooth all hair up and off the face into a very tight ponytail with the base of the tail resting at the back of the crown. You may also opt to wear a fringe if you prefer.

Step 2 Attach an add-on long lush pony like The Sleek Pony by PutOnPieces. The Sleek Pony is a straight, smooth mid-length synthetic hairpiece that is applied simply by a claw clip. The top is 8 inches long, the back is 5.5 inches and the overall length is 12 inches. The pieces are long and sleek and come in a variety of hues.

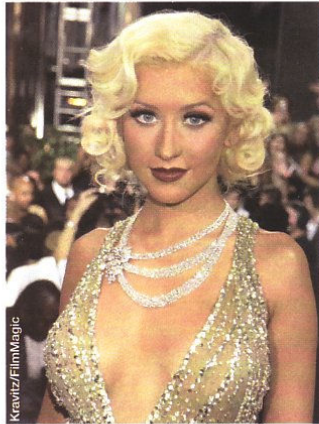
Step 3 Smooth the pony with your fingers.

Step 4 After the pony is securely in place, separate a one- to two-inch section of your own hair and twist it up and over the clip after you have attached the pony.

The top is 23 inches long, the back is 19 inches and the overall length is 27 inches. The pieces are long and sleek and come in a variety of hues.

Step 3 Smooth the pony with your fingers.

Step 4 Wrap the bottom hair into a few flat pin curls.

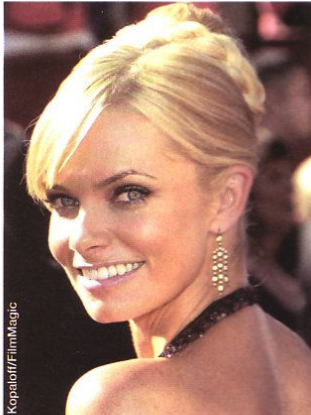

Step 1 Create a center part.

Step 2 Using a brush, comb or your fingers, smooth all hair up and off the face into a tight low ponytail with the base of the tail resting at the base of the neck.

Step 3 Attach an add-on long lush long wavy pony like The Bounce Pony by PutOnPieces. The Bounce Pony is a wavy piece with shoulder-length layers on a claw clip attachment for instant installation. The top is 10 inches long, the bottom is 12 inches and the overall length is 19 inches. The piece is long and sassy and comes in a variety of hues.

Step 4 Attach the pony to the base of your hair. After the pony is securely in place, finger touse and arrange with one side worn over the shoulder.

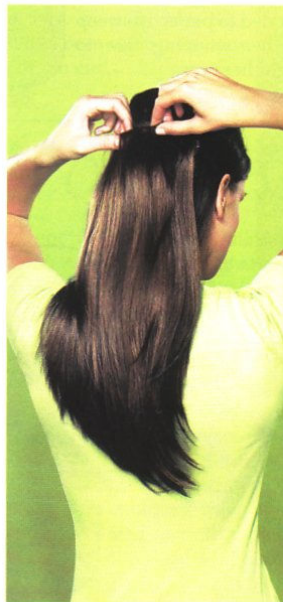
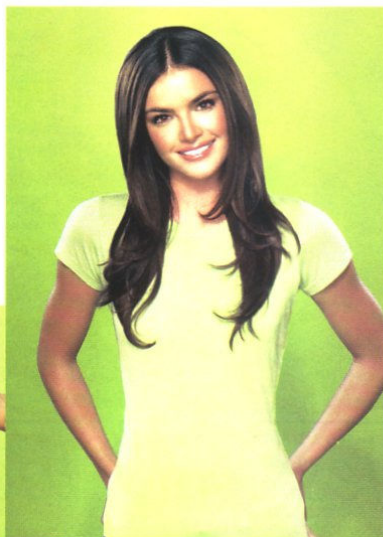

Step 3 Clip the top hair up and away.

Step 4 Wrap the bottom hair into a few flat pin curls.

Step 5 Simply snap on the HairDo 22-inch One Piece Clip-in Human Hair Extensions in a shade designed to match or contrast your existing hair.

Step 6 Unclip the top hair and finger touse.

Step 3 Clip the top hair up and away.

Step 4 Wrap the bottom hair into a few flat pin curls.

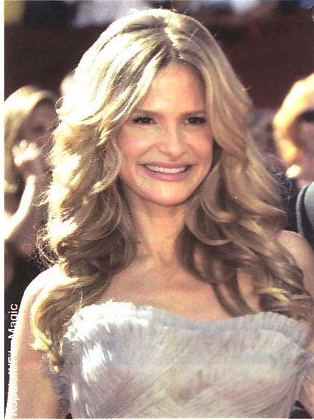

Step 4 Wrap the bottom hair into a few flat pin curls.

Step 5 Simply snap on the PutOnPieces 10 Piece Extension Wavy Extension Kit in the desired hue.

Step 6 Unclip the top hair and finger tousle.

Ask the Hair Doctor

Q I love the updo Reese Witherspoon wore to the Oscars. Can you tell me how to recreate it? Thank you!—Cecelia from NYC

A Reese Witherspoon was a big winner in more ways than one at the recent 2006 Oscar Award ceremony. Not only did she snag the gold statue for her leading role as June Carter Cash, her buttery-blond tresses were magnificently coiled into a soft sultry hair chignon. The good news is that anyone with tresses long enough to pull into a low ponytail can instantly steal her award-winning style. Just follow the steps below for your own sultry bun that you can dress up, down or adorn with flowers, hair accessories or just a high shine hairspray.

The secret to this successful and stunning chignon style is based on a ponytail or add-on pony that is positioned to perch just a few inches off the neck. You also need enough "pony" hair to fan it out into a soft roll that is easy to do but needs some finger picking and arranging. Depending on your face shape, hair texture and type, work with your stylist to select whether you should go with an off-center parted crown like Reese did, or whether you should add a soft fringe. Follow the steps listed below to steal Reese Witherspoon's Oscar winning chignon hairstyle:

Step 1 To duplicate Reese's sleek chignon, shampoo hair with a product designed to address your hair's special needs. If you color, highlight or chemically treat your hair, select a shampoo that supports those treatments. Ponytails are often easier to

style when hair is slightly aged from the last shampoo. Newly washed, soft or slippery hair, can often be trickier to work with than "day old" hair.

Step 2 Apply the appropriate rinse-out conditioners. (Avoid if hair is super thin or fine).

Step 3 Finish with a cool/cold water rinse to close cuticles and encourage natural shine.

Step 4 Towel-blot and apply very light cocktail of desired leave-in detangler, conditioner or styling products (firm holding mousse or gel).

Step 5 For extra volume along the crown, apply a volumizing product such as PhytoVolume Actif or similar. You can also apply a firm holding or sculpting gel.

Step 6 Blow-dry hair straight using a blow dryer with a concentrator attachment. If hair is naturally curly or wavy, apply a straightening balm like Phytodefrisant or similar to damp strands. Use a boar's head style paddle brush and separate hair into individual sections.

Step 7 When hair is completely dry, spray entire head with a firm holding spray. To get more pronounced fullness around the crown back-comb slightly. Work from side to side focusing special attention on the root and crown areas.

Step 8 After hair has the desired fullness spray the entire head with another spritz of firm hold hairspray like PhytoPro Strong Finishing Spray or similar.

Step 9 Use a boar's bristle brush or your fingers to direct all of the hair away from the face towards the back of the head. Gather hair into a ponytail with a base that rests right above the nape of the neck. Before attaching a hair-friendly bungee band or Blax in



the same color as your hair, make sure that the crown and sides are smooth.

Step 10 Separate the newly formed ponytail into one- to two-inch sections. Working with individual sections, spritz with hairspray and then wrap around the outside of a large-barrel curling iron. Release the newly formed curl and pin carefully to back of your scalp.

Step 11 When the entire pony tail is curled and the new curls are 100% cool, release the pins holding them into place.

Step 12 Brush pony to integrate the new curls.

Step 13 Wrap the ponytail by lifting the bottom of the tail and gently wrapping it up and over the top of your elastic. Depending on the length of your hair, you will be able to wrap one or more times.

Step 14 Keep the finished bun soft and loose. Use your fingers to arrange the finished chignon into the desired size and shape. You may want to wear it looser or tighter, depending on your own personal preference.

Step 15 Use bobby pins in the same color as your hair and pin around the edges. Stagger the bobby pins according to how loose or tight you wish to wear the finished chignon.

Step 16 When the bun is pinned to your desired placement spray well with firm holding styling spray like PhytoPro Strong Finishing Spray.

Step 17 Apply a light touch of shine product to add shimmer. Remember not to apply too much shine product.

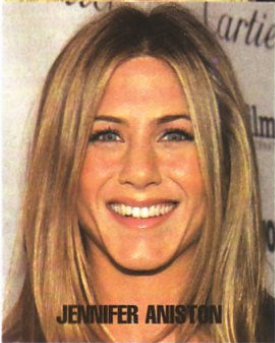
